We will have the honor to talk to **Sally Ranney**, a dedicated environmental activist from the USA who worked with three US Presidents (Carter, Reagan, Clinton), founder and member of many committees. She has been a life partner of Ted Turner (CNN) for many years and is very active in his projects for the conservation of nature and other philanthropy. In Celje we will be in a dialogue with exceptional guests - besides Sally Ranney, there will be two other inspiring guests with us: Dr. Nina Meyerhof and Gregor Delej, touched upon the pressing present-day climate change, the role of sustainable development, the preservation of nature, the role of young people in creating a future based on sustainable peace. An important role will be devoted to the model of small cities that can be an active sandbox, where new models and modes of operation are being tested, where social innovations are born (positive social changes).

Dr. Nina Meyerhof has dedicated her life to working for the betterment of children`s lives through developing empowerment processes with a focus on self-esteem, democratic living skills, understanding one's spiritual nature and furthering a local to global perspective. As President and Founder of Children of the Earth, she is a visionary thought leader recognized for a life of advocating for children and youth.

Gregor Deleja from the Gimnazija Celje - Center, one of the more advanced and inspiring principals in Slovenia. In addition to managerial obligations, he teaches music and piano, leads school choirs and boys' a capella ensembles, takes care of international exchange programs and monitors students on trips home and abroad. He is popular with both parents and students.

The purpose of the debate is to form a Think Tank; a community that develops new ideas with the goal of bringing concrete measures everyone can accept. We want decision-makers to listen to what people actually want and to take urgent action to protect the Global Commons.

Round table topics:

- What should be the **3 priorities** in creating a sustainable world? (**access to clean water + access to the internet and information + all energy coming from renewable sources**) - We can do that!
- **The fact that climate change is not 50 or 75 y away - it is 10 - 15!!!** How are we going to keep the world going in the direction of peace and sustainability?
- **'Global - Commons'** Forests and Oceans - super-life support systems that impact societies, economies and the biodiversity of our entire planet. + **Arctic and Antarctic**
- **Global Choices + Global Voices + Global Active Citizens = for Global Commons** (to consciously collaborate on protecting our planetary ecosystems.)
