

A PART OF EU 2030

PROJECT SUMMARY:

In 2015 World leaders committed to achieving 17 developmental goals to serve as a ‘blueprint to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all’ by 2030. These goals cover issues such as education, poverty, climate, hunger, equality, peace, partnerships and innovation. The universality of these goals obligated all nations to work toward achieving them, both inside their own borders and globally.

A Part of EU 2030 is a project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union with a four member consortium across Europe, including African Media Association Malta. In keeping with the SDG's leave no one behind principle, the project seeks to increase awareness and promote youth participation in civic and democratic activities, towards achieving the agenda 2030 particularly among youth migrants, minorities, and third countries nationals since these groups do not actively participate in their communities due to different socioeconomic factors.

The major objective of the project is to promote the participation of young migrants, third country Nationals and Minorities in contributing towards the achievement of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals of the Agenda 2030 through civic and democratic activities.

Participants of the project activities will receive trainings centered around the SDGs of the 2030 Agenda, tools to promote youth participation, content creation and dissemination techniques for promoting the SDGs on their social networks.

A Part of EU 2030 project has the following specific objectives:

To develop activities that promote the participation of young migrants, minorities and third country nationals through five areas of participation: Social and Political Participation, Sports and Culture, Voluntarism, Family and Training and Employment.

Raise awareness and provide knowledge on the relevance of the SDGs at the local, national and international level focused on the general population.

For this reason partners of the consortium will create a Local Youth Council that, with the support of two youth workers (10 youngsters and 2 youth workers in total), will receive training on each of the Sustainable Development Goals defined in the 2030 Agenda, as well as specific methodologies to create activities that encourage participation through non-formal education models. The young beneficiaries of the project, organized in the Local Youth Councils, will oversee leading the awareness campaign, through the production of short films and diffusion materials for social media made in each country.

In these short films, the young people will transfer what they have learnt during the training, in order to raise awareness among the general population, and especially among the young population, about the importance of participation to achieve the different SDG framed in the 2030 Agenda.

In addition, different posters, leaflets, press releases, and publications on social networks will be produced to increase the impact of the awareness-raising campaign.

The Local Youth Council consist of ten participants. In order to optimise the achievement of APOFEU's objectives, a dedicated multilingual website <https://www.apartofeu2030.eu/> , as well as social media profiles has been created.
