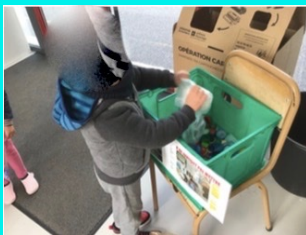
The charity lent us some sensory games and books about difference and disability.
